### Registration Certificate for Producer (Under Rule 4 of Battery Waste Management Rules, 2022)

**M/s SAMYAK SURANA** is hereby granted registration as Producer of Waste/used Battery in line with the provisions under Battery Waste Management Rules, 2022 for disposal of waste/used batteries. This certificate of registration shall be valid for a period of five years from the date of issue of this letter unless revoked / suspended / cancelled. The registration is granted subject to the following terms & conditions:

1. The Producer shall ensure necessary actions and compliance to the provisions as stipulated under Rule 4 of Battery Waste Management Rules, 2022.
2. Waste Battery collected by the Producer shall be sent for recycling or refurbishing and shall not be sent for landfilling or incineration.
3. Producer shall file for renewal of registration in Form 1(A) before sixty days of its expiry.
4. Producer shall inform the Central Pollution Control Board of any changes to the information contained in the Extended Producer Responsibility Plan and of any permanent cessation as regards to the making available on the market of the Battery referred to in the Extended Producer Responsibility Plan.
5. In order to develop a separate waste stream for collection of Waste Battery for fulfilling Extended Producer Responsibility obligations, the Producer, may operate schemes such as deposit refund system or buy back or any other model.
6. In order to meet the obligations of Extended Producer Responsibility, the Producer may engage itself or authorise any other entity for collection, recycling or refurbishment of Waste Battery. However, the obligations of meeting the Extended Producer Responsibility targets shall remain with the Producer.
7. Producer shall file annual returns in Form 3 regarding the Waste Battery collected and recycled or refurbished towards fulfilling obligations under Extended Producer Responsibility with the Central Pollution Control Board and concerned State Pollution Control Board in Form 3 by 30th June of the next financial year. The details of the registered recyclers from whom the Extended Producer Responsibility certificates have been procured shall also be provided.
8. It shall be the responsibility of a Producer to, – (i) adhere to prohibitions and labelling requirements as prescribed in Schedule I; (ii) ensure safe handling of Battery or Waste Battery such that no damage to human health and environment occurs.
9. Producer shall not handover the used / waste battery to recycler / refurbisher not having registration mandated under these BWM Rules.
10. CPCB shall suspend and / or cancel the registration and / or impose Environment Compensation in case of non-compliance of Extended Producers Responsibility obligations.
11. Action as deemed fit under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 including levying Environment Compensation will be taken for violation to Battery Waste Management Rules, 2022.

The Registration is granted under the PWM Rules, 2016 (as amended) subject to the following terms & conditions: -

1. Registration granted for PIBOs under the PWM Rules, 2016 (as amended), does not require renewal and shall be changed only on the request of Producers, Importers & Brand

owners, under the existing Extended Producer Responsibility registration.

2. The Importer shall fulfil the EPR Targets as specified in the above table. For the subsequent years, EPR Target shall be auto-generated based on the information provided in the Annual report, the format of which shall be specified by CPCB and displayed on the EPR Portal.
3. The Importer shall provide EPR certificates of the same category of plastic waste only from registered plastic waste processors for fulfilling their EPR obligation.
4. Exchange of EPR credit between PIBOs and Plastic Waste Processors (PWP) to be done as per mechanism provided by CPCB.
5. The Importer shall not deal with any entity not registered through on-line centralized portal developed by Central Pollution Control Board.
6. The Importer shall not engage in manufacture, stocking, distribution, selling of banned SUP items as listed in Amendment to PWM Rules dated August 12, 2021.
7. In case, it is found or determined that any PIBO registered on the on-line portal has provided false information or has willfully concealed information or there is any irregularity or deviation from the conditions stipulated while obtaining registration under Extended Producer Responsibility guidelines, then the registration of such an entity would be revoked for a one - year period after giving an opportunity to be heard. The entities whose registration has been revoked shall not be able to register afresh for the period of revocation.
8. The Importer should ensure compliance with provisions of the PWM Rules, 2016, as amended. Action, as deemed fit, including revocation of registration, closure of unit, levying Environmental Compensation charges, shall be taken against violators of PWM Rules.
9. CPCB/SPCB/PCC reserves the right to take such action as deemed fit under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for violation of PWM Rules, 2016, as amended, if any, by the concerned PIBO for the period prior to grant of registration.

3. The Authorisation shall be valid for a period of five (5) years from date of issue with following conditions:

- i. You shall strictly follow the approved Extended Producer Responsibility plan, a copy of which is enclosed herewith as Enclosure-I;
- ii. You shall ensure that collection mechanism or collection Centres are set up or designated as per the details given in the Extended Producer Responsibility plan and that shall be completed before the proposed dates if any in the EPR Plan (list of collection Centres and the toll free numbers for reverse logistics enclosed);
- iii. You shall ensure that all the collected e-waste is channelized to your dismantler/recycler M/s Global Waste Solution, Ram Nagar, Ganaur, Sonipat and records shall be maintained at dismantler/ recycler and your end;
- iv. You shall maintain records, in Form-2 of these Rules, of e-waste and make such records available for scrutiny by Central Pollution Control Board;
- v. You shall file annual returns in Form-3 to the Central Pollution Control Board on or before 30th day of June following the financial year to which that returns relates.

vi. General Terms & Conditions of the Authorisation:

- a. The authorisation shall comply with provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the E-waste (Management) Rules, 2016 made there under;
- b. The authorisation or its renewal shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer authorised by the Central Pollution Control Board;
- c. Any change in the approved Extended Producer Responsibility plan should be informed to Central Pollution Control Board within 15 days on which decision shall be communicated by Central Pollution Control Board within sixty days;
- d. It is the duty of the authorised person to take prior permission of the Central Pollution Control Board to close down any collection centre/points or any other facility which are part of the EPR plan;
- e. An application for the renewal of authorisation shall be made as laid down in sub-rule (vi) of rule of 13(1) the E- Waste (Management) Rules, 2016;
- f. The Board reserves right to cancel/amend/revoke the authorisation at any time as per the policy of the Board or Government

**vii. Additional Conditions: -**

- a) That the applicant will submit annual sales data along with annual returns;
- b) That the applicant has to ensure that the addresses of collection points provided by them in their EPR Plan are correct and traceable and the collection points/centres are functional;
- c) That the applicant will submit revised application for grant of EPR Authorisation in case of applicant adding/changing PRO or changing its EPR Plan;
- d) That the applicant has to ensure that the e-waste collected at collection centres/points or through Buy-back and DRS mentioned in the application should reach to its authorized dismantler/recycler;
- e) That the applicant has to submit to CPCB every quarter the amount of E-waste (in weight) of EEE code ITEW1 (Mainframe & Minicomputer), ITEW2, ITEW3, ITEW4, ITEW5, ITEW6, ITEW7, ITEW8, ITEW14, ITEW15 (Smart Phones & Feature phones) & CEEW1, collected in that quarter and recycled;
- f) That the applicant has to submit Enclosure-A of the self-declaration whenever it launches any new model of its product;
- g) That the applicant has to provide RoHS information on the booklet and brochures of their Products;
- h) That the applicant has to ensure that the Bills/Invoices of sale of EEE have to contain information on toll free number, web site link for collection, channelization of e-waste;
- i) That the applicant has to maintain all the technical documentation on RoHS for verification by CPCB/SPCB whenever required;
- j) In case of any violation of the above condition, your authorization will be suspended/ cancelled;
